Adelaide Wildcats Netball Club (Wildcats) is a family and community netball club based on the strong foundations and traditions of Clovelly and Glandore. Wildcats have a strong belief in attracting and developing junior players in our supportive and friendly club, with a view to encouraging long term participation in netball. The club is committed to promoting a healthy, active lifestyle for families and the local community, in a competitive and enjoyable environment.

Wildcats currently field teams in the Adelaide Metropolitan Netball Division (AMND) and City Night Division at Netball SA Stadium for age grade (Sub Primary upwards) and Senior Players (through to AMND League).

The Adelaide Wildcats is currently advertising for the Inter Team #1 coach position for the 2018 season.

The Wildcats Way

To create a positive environment where players feel welcomed, valued and supported. To have a positive influence on the players netball and life experience, to develop player's skills and wellbeing, and provide a pathway for their development.

The Wildcats Way means our players will be known and remembered for:

- Being skilled players
- Being disciplined
- Showing respect to each other and the opposition and officials
- Playing fairly
- Winning and losing graciously
- Being 'good sports' – thanking the opposition, shaking hands and for the Captain to thank the officials after each game
- Enjoying their netball

The Wildcats Way means our coaches will:

- Undergo coach accreditation at the Club's expense
- Support the Wildcats Way in sentiment, deed and action
- Show respect to their players, the opposition and officials
- Win and lose graciously
- Develop players skills and wellbeing

Wildcats Way Approach

We train how we are to play; we will get out of it as much as we are prepared to put in. Our coaching and playing methodology will be based around the Australian 'Dare to be a Diamond' framework, which is:

- Australian-style defence, being one-on-one, tight defence in all contests (unless a pre-planned set zone has been agreed at higher grade levels).
- When there is a stoppage, two players will set up next to each other, in front of the penalty pass with both making leads in the opposite direction. This will always provide two options for every pass, and will be the main catalyst for our attacking style of play.
- The Wildcats Way ensures that all coaches and team utilise consistent set plays and approaches to match play, including liaison with the head coach.

Position Scope:

To provide high level coaching experience to the Adelaide Wildcats Netball Club throughout the 2018 Winter season. The successful candidate will act primarily as coach of the top Inter team, as well as mentoring other Inter coaches as required and driving the integration of Intermediate players through the Inter Development Program for their transition to senior netball.

Role and Responsibilities:

- Coach the Inter team #1.
- Assist the Head Coach and A Grade Coach with the development and implementation of the Inter Development Program through the integration of the Intermediate/senior players.
- Attend coaching information sessions as required during the season.
- Participate in club events, including the coordination of Inter participation at the Season Launch, Kittens Clinics and Club Day.

Selection Criteria:

Candidates for the position of Inter team #1 Coach will require coaching experience of Inter players, as well as having a range of personal and professional skills. The following skills and qualifications are essential requirements for the position:

- Netball SA Foundation coaching accreditation or higher and an interest in achieving high qualifications.
- Current member of Netball SA Coaches and Umpires Association
- Current Police Clearance (or be intending to gain in 2018).

Knowledge and Skills:

- Proven abilities in coaching Inter teams.
- Demonstrated abilities developing players ready for transition to higher grades.
- Demonstrated abilities in working with age grade players.
- High attention to detail demonstrated in all aspects of work.
- Outstanding organisational skills, excellent communication and interpersonal skills.
- Demonstrated interpersonal, communication, facilitation and written skills, with the ability to interact with a range of stakeholder groups.

Personal Attributes:

- A strong commitment to the development of players including age grade and the role that sport plays in children's lives.
- Ability to display personal responsibility for transparent decision making.
- Excellent personal presentation.
- Excellent organisational abilities of time and resources.
- Leads by example and has integrity and willingness to model the values of the Wildcats Netball Club.
- Contribute to the overall success of the Wildcats Netball Club through open and honest communication, respect for others and reporting progress as required.
