

2020/2021 SUMMER NETBALL INFORMATION

Welcome to the 2020/2021 City Night Summer season. Trials for the 2020/2021 summer season will be held on Sunday 30th August, Wednesday 2nd September & Sunday 6th September at the Clovelly Park courts (York Ave, Clovelly Park)

To have the opportunity to be placed in a team you will need to register and **pay full fees by:**
Sunday 30th August 2020

REGISTRATION & TRIAL PROCESS

All Summer Applications to trial must be completed online through our club's *My Netball* database.

If you have **EVER** played netball before, your information will exist on the database, this includes winter, summer, interstate or Net Set Go clinics. You should have received an email with your login ID, but if not, you can find it at <http://my.netball.com.au/common/pages/noauth/AccountRecovery.aspx>

DO NOT use “**New Participants**” box to register if you have played Netball in Australia as you will be creating a second or duplicate profile in the database. Only use “**New Participant**” at time of registration if you have **never** played netball in an association affiliated with Netball Australia. If you have **any** questions about this process, please contact the club at netball@adelaidewildcats.com.au.

From your My Netball profile, you will be able to register for Summer 2020/2021. Just make sure that your “**Current Organisation**” (top right hand corner next to your name) is set to Adelaide Wildcats. You will then be able to select the Adelaide Wildcats 2020/2021 Summer Registration from the “My Forms & Purchases” (bottom left hand corner).

You can pay fees via the My Netball site at the time of registration.

- Payment will be required as part of the online sign up process. You will not be able to re-enter the site to make payment once registration is complete.
- If payment is not complete prior to Trial 1, you/your child will be unable to participate in trials.
- If a player withdraws after registration, but prior to team selection the season fee will be refunded less a \$100 registration fee.
- If a player is placed in a team and subsequently withdraws, no refund will be provided.
- A full refund will be provided to players who are not able to be placed in a team.
- All refunds will be processed approximately 4 weeks from final teams being confirmed.

Please note that registration does not guarantee selection in a team. The club reserves the right not to nominate teams if the mix of player positions is not suitable, or if we have insufficient volunteers to coach/manage teams. This summer we will be seeking parents to nominate to coach their child's team as much as possible to assist with giving some of our regular coaches a well-deserved rest over the summer season. Please indicate your willingness to support a team!

Attendance at trials will ensure team selection is made based on a player's ability. Selection in teams will be made based on the ability of players as demonstrated at trials, with past experience being taken into some consideration *if required*. Selections will be advised via email to the address provided at registration.

Players who do not attend trials cannot be guaranteed a place in a team, or in a grade that is of a standard appropriate to their ability.

TRIAL VENUES

All trials will take place at the Clovelly Park courts located at York Ave, Clovelly Park.

TRIAL TIMES

Trial times for each grade will be finalised and published once registrations have closed. This will allow the club to more efficiently plan the trial days around numbers nominated in each grade.

Trials will be scheduled for each grade within the following times:

Sunday 30th August & Sunday 6th September – between 9am and 1:30pm

Wednesday 2nd September – between 6pm and 9pm

We are again offering the multiple player family discount. The discount will be applied as follows:

- 10% discount on the second family member
- 20% discount on the third family member

The discount is applied to the younger family member first. If you are unsure of the application of the discount to please contact the treasurer prior to trials to determine the correct amount of payment.

SEASON INFORMATION

ASSISTANCE:

Adelaide Wildcats Netball Club would like to hear from anyone interested in coaching, managing or umpiring in the 2020/2021 summer season as we will be seeking additional volunteers to assist with coaching teams for this season to allow our regular coaches to have a break where required. Without officials, the club will not be able to nominate teams. PLAYER ABSENCE DURING SEASON:

The Committee has given much consideration to the summer netball competition. Over the past few seasons, some players have not taken the summer season as seriously or been able to commit as they should. This has meant last minute withdrawals of players from teams, numerous calls by coaches to find fill in players, forfeits, fines and additional fill in registration fees.

If you know you will be absent for any period of time during the season (work, holidays, etc) please advise this on your registration in the space provided. If you know you will be absent for any longer than 3 weeks, you should probably consider whether you should nominate for a team or be used as a fill in player throughout the season.

Given the costs the club has borne due to last minute forfeit of games and additional registration costs for fill in players, the following will be adopted for the 2020/2021 summer season for all teams:

- Any player who withdraws from a game later than 9am on the day of the game will be fined \$15.
- This will allow the club time to find and pay for a fill in player.
- A player who has been fined for the above reason will be unable to take the court until the fine has been paid.

The club regrets the need to introduce this policy, but felt the need to do so given the increasing lateness of players pulling out, impacting on our ability to fill teams each week, resulting in teams taking the court with only 6 players which isn't fair on the rest of the team and the costs as a result of the behaviour. The club felt that fining individual players was a fairer option than increasing all players' fees to cover these costs.

HEAT POLICY:

If the Heat Policy is activated, the Club Secretary will be notified, and the information will also appear on the Netball SA and City Night website after 1pm. Coaches will advise players if the Heat Policy is activated.
